

## **Team Expectations**

Each team is responsible for paying \$40 for every weekend that they are scheduled to play. A pay summary will be sent during the season to notify each club of their cost for the program based on the number of games scheduled and the number of games hosted. Any cancellations after the schedules are released will not be refunded.

The Host Club is responsible for scheduling all referees. Referees may consist of one WIAA and one non-WIAA ref. If students are utilized they should be a high school player and comfortable enough to call the game.

**Teams must each provide one person to run the clock or the book for every game.**

## **Game Rules:**

- Game Warm Ups- five (5) minute period
- Two-Twenty (20) minute halves with continuous clock, except for the last minute of the game.
  - The entire first half and the first 19 minutes of the second half, the clock is only stopped with an officials timeout.
  - During the last minute of the game, the clock stops on all dead balls. (Clock workers-please watch the officials for when to start and stop the clock)
- **A book will be kept and fouls will be tracked. WIAA guidelines for fouls are in effect. A player will foul out after 5 personal fouls. 7th Team foul is bonus and 10th is double.**
- Goal of the league is try as much as possible to get kids equal playing time.
- Practice balls will not be provided prior to game or between halves
- 3 timeouts per game per team
- Man to Man defense to be played at all levels
- Five (5) minute half time.
- **All tied games at the end of regulation play will result in 1 one-minute overtime. All games tied at the end of the one minute overtime will end in a tie.**
- **Pressing is only allowed in the last minute of the game, except for a team with a 10 pt lead**
- Technical foul is an automatic two (2) points and scoring team retains ball
- Two (2) technical fouls by a player or coach will result in ejection for the remainder of the day
- Referees have the final say
- Teams, Coaches and Fans are encouraged to demonstrate good sportsmanship
- **Coaches should adhere to the "no standing" guideline of WIAA**
  - **First offense is a verbal warning**
  - **Second offense is a technical foul.**
- Unless otherwise noted WIAA rules are in effect
